Track & Field

The high school boys and girls track team competed at the PIAA district one championships. Azarhis Smith won CCSA's first Delaware County individual track championship in the high jump. Senior Mariam Koita won the district championship in both the 100 and 200 meters with school-record times. Zach Howard won the 110-meter hurdles and placed 3rd in the 300-meter hurdles. Koita, Howard, Armani Madden, and Malachi Holmes will continue their season at the PA state championships later this month.

Basketball

After being crowned District 1 Class A Champions, the varsity boys' basketball team made it all the way to the state playoff quarter-finals in their first-ever showing at the state championships. The team was led by a core group of seniors who set a brilliant example for their younger teammates. A tough loss against Linville Hill Christian Academy ended the championship run for the Sabers, but the team is already looking toward next season.
