## Calendar Notes

- Inclement Weather: The scheduling and use of make-up days, if needed, will be determined by the Board of Education of Calvert County. Possible make-up days for inclement weather and emergency school closing include, at a minimum, the following dates: 3/1, 5/24, and days added to the end of the school year.
- Delayed Opening and Early Dismissal Days: If on a given day when schools have a scheduled two-hour early dismissal, and a two-hour delayed opening is announced, students will NOT be dismissed early and will remain in school until the end of their regular school day. (Schools will open two hours late and end at the regularly scheduled time since the planned early dismissal will be canceled.)
- Virtual Asynchronous Days: Learning will occur virtually at home on days indicated as Virtual Asynchronous Days. All instructional
  materials and assignments will be posted in Schoology, and students in Prekindergarten through Grade 2 will be provided a packet.
- **Eleven-Month Employee Schedule:** Eleven-month employees should schedule the additional work time beyond the 190-day, tenmonth employee calendar above with their supervisors.
- Religious Observances: CCPS will operate on a normal schedule on the following days of major religious observance: Rosh Hashanah: September 15, Yom Kippur: September 25, Diwali: November 12, Ramadan: March 11, Eid al-Fitr: April 10, and Eid al-Adha: June 17. Jewish and Muslim religious observance dates begin at sundown the evening before the dates noted and conclude at sundown the next evening. Ramadan begins Sunday, March 10, and ends on Monday, April 8. Students who miss school due to religious observance will be marked legally absent when a note is provided.
