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In light of the governor's announcement as well as information presented at the school board meeting on August 11th, below are a few highlights specific to students receiving programs and services. Please keep in mind that this is an evolving plan and is subject to change. If you have further questions, feel free to contact the CSE office or email reopen@frankfort-schuyler.org.

The first day of school is scheduled to begin September 14th.

Grades K-2

- All students in grades K-2 will be attending school Monday-Thursday each week.
- Programs and services will be met within school hours as per your child's IEP or 504 plan.

Grades 3-5

- Any student who has an IEP will be attending school Monday-Thursday <u>each week</u>. Programs and services will be met within school hours as per your child's IEP.
- Students who have a 504 plan will follow the hybrid model of the elementary school: One week in school Monday-Thursday; one week virtual Monday-Thursday. Services will be provided according to the hybrid model to the greatest extent possible.

Grades 6-8

- For the first 5 weeks of school, any student who is in a special class program (15:1 or 12:1:1) will be attending school in person Monday-Thursday each week. Programs and services will be met within school hours as per your child's IEP.
- Students who receive Resource Room, Consultant Teacher, only related services, or has a 504 plan will follow the virtual model of the middle school: Services will be provided virtually to the greatest extent possible.

Grades 9-12

- For the first 10 weeks of school, any student who is in a special class program (15:1 or 12:1:1) will be attending school Monday-Thursday each week. Programs and services will be met within school hours as per your child's IEP.
- Students who receive Resource Room, Consultant Teacher, only related services, or has a 504 plan will follow the virtual model of the high school: Services will be provided virtually to the greatest extent possible.
- 11th and 12th grade students receiving Resource Room support <u>and</u> attend CTE will be coming to school a half day per week. Mrs. Talarico will be contacting you with more specifics on days and times in the near future.

I understand this is a very difficult and stressful time with so many unknowns. I commend you, as parents and guardians, as we navigate these uncharted waters and you attempt to prepare your children for the upcoming school year.
