PLEDGE

PUBLIC COMMENT

Stephanie Arredondo addressed the board about the Superintendent search. She wants the board to consider what the parents want in a Superintendent. She would like the Board to consider a candidate from outside the district. She would like to see a community survey go out and would like the board to keep in mind that the district is growing.

April Garvin addressed the board about the Superintendent search. She is requesting the new Superintendent be hired from outside the district. She would like the new Superintendent to uphold conservative values. She would like to see a community survey go out as well as a Town Hall meeting. She also requested transparency throughout the process.

Georgia Head addressed the board about the closed executive session. She objects to the closed session training and requested that the meeting be cancelled. She stated that the meeting was not in compliance with the law and will file suit if meeting is not cancelled. She stated that meeting should be transparent. She also stated that JISD will be liable for the attorney fees if suit is filed.
