## 6. Review revised board policies

The committee approved the revised board policies (BP) listed below as amended (see notes below for BP 6142.1 and BP 6146.1) and recommended they be approved by the full board:

- BP 6142.1 – Sexual Health and HIV/AIDS Prevention Instruction – Amend to include information about Education Code section 51938 related to parent/guardian consent.
- BP 6146.1 – High School Graduation Requirements – Consider amending the second paragraph under the section titled, “Exemptions from SBCEO Graduation Requirements,” that talks about students who transfer to SBCEO county-operated programs after completing the second year of high school being exempt from additional adopted graduation requirements, to allow for students who transfer after completing only the first year of high school to be exempt from additional adopted graduation requirements. Additionally, amend # 7 in the numbered list on page one of the BP to clarify that it is the graduating class of 2029-30.
- BP 6162.6 – Use of Copyrighted Materials
- BP 6173 – Education for Homeless Children
- BP 6173.1 – Education for Foster Youth
