Students must be 18 years or older and have valid CPR cards (see website) plus proof of Covid vaccinations per clinical requirements.

COURSES

EMT - Semester Course

Upon successful completion of coursework & exams, students will receive an EMT-1 Course Completion Certificate and will be eligible to take the National Registry Exam to be a California EMT-1.

EMT ACCELERATED - 5.5 Week Course

Accelerated full-time version of EMT Semester Course.

EMT REFRESHER - Four-Day Course

Meets California's 32-hour classroom refresher requirement & skills refresher requirement plus portions of the National Registry's reregistrations requirements for EMT Basics.

EMT SKILLS - One-Day Course

For students interested in skill testing. Takes place on last day of EMT Refresher course.

JOB DUTIES

- Respond to 911 calls for emergency medical assistance such as cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) or bandaging a wound
- Assess a patient's condition and determine a course of treatment
- Provide first aid treatment or life support care to sick or injured patients
- Transport patients safely in an ambulance
- Transfer patients to the emergency department of a hospital or other healthcare facility
- Report observations & treatment to physicians, nurses, and other medical professionals
- Document medical care given to patients
- Inventory, replace, and clean supplies and equipment after use
