

Grant County Farm Bureau/George Turner Memorial Scholarship

Instructions and Information

Each year, the Grant County Farm Bureau offers up to (3) \$1,000.00 scholarships. These scholarships are awarded to high school or undergraduate students who are enrolling or are currently enrolled in an accredited college or university. A person may receive the scholarship only once, and must meet the following requirements.

Applicant must be:

1. A member, or the son, daughter, or legal dependent of a Grant County Farm Bureau member family with a current membership
2. Will be attending an accredited college/university
3. Preference preferred but not required to be enrolled in a field of agriculture, e.g. food science, horticulture, ag technical course, animal science, etc. or in course as it relates to agriculture

To apply, submit with attached cover sheet the following:

1. A copy of high school grade transcript (must also include spring term just completed). GPA must be 2.0 or better
2. At least two letters of recommendation.
3. A 1 to 2 page essay on your choice of vocation or profession and your future role in life.
4. A summary of your activities and service to your high school (FFA, extra-curricular activities, student government, departmental clubs, etc.); to your community (4-H, service projects, church, etc.); to your family (how you have helped with your family's farming enterprise or other family responsibilities); and all work experience. This may be submitted as a resume and may include any awards received.
5. Submit a brief essay on the importance of Farm Bureau. Indicate how you envision your involvement in an agricultural leadership role in the future.
6. Prepare a proposed budget for the coming school year (expenses: tuition, books, room and board, etc.) indicating how you plan to pay for your education beyond this scholarship (assets: savings, wages, parental support, other scholarships, etc.).
7. Submit your letter of acceptance or college enrollment printout or signed statement from advisor.
8. Provide a photo of yourself suitable for publication.

Applicants will be judged at the county level on the basis of:

Essay on Choice of Vocation of Profession (30)
Academics (classes chosen to prepare for career choice) (15)
GPA (5)
Community and School Activities (20)
Work and Service to Family (15)
Essay on Importance of Farm Bureau (10)
Budget (5)

Total Points 100

- Winners will be announced at graduation.
- Payment will be made directly to the college/university registrar's office in winner's name.
- A scholarship shall be used in the year following its award. In the event the scholarship is not used within a year's time, the recipient must present a request for a time extension. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture.
