Overview:

The Lead Teacher is responsible for providing a Montessori classroom/instructional program that supports the individual needs of the children in accordance with the school's mission/vision and the Montessori Philosophy. **This position would finish its duties in March 2024 (approximately).**

Duties and Responsibilities:

• Plan and implement Montessori curriculum, developmentally appropriate practice, and Montessori philosophy.

• Carefully prepare Montessori environment which is conducive to learning and appropriate to the physical, social, cognitive, and emotional development of students.

• Present large group, small group, and individual lessons as appropriate, based on knowledge of developmental plans and educational readiness of each child.

· Assess and record student progress through observation and interaction.

• Thoughtfully communicate with parents for conferences, concerns, academic progress and with Director of Montessori for short and long term curriculum plans and goals.

• Interact respectfully with the children in a way which honors the dignity of each child.

 \cdot Work with co-teacher to develop and record student progress reports.

 \cdot Maintain open, friendly, and cooperative relationships with each child's family and encourage their involvement in the program

 \cdot Continue professional development through attending workshops, conferences and other staff development.

 \cdot Attend faculty meetings and in-service days and maintain state certification requirements.

· Demonstrate behavior that is professional, ethical, and responsible.

· Maintain confidentiality at all times.

· Support children throughout transitions including car line, lunch, nap and recess.
