

MILITARY

Military recruiters will be invited to campus once a month and available for students during all lunches. ASVAB will be offered January 10, 2023.



Community/Junior Colleges and Trade Schools Financial Aid accepted - FAFSA/TAFSA

Trade or Technical Schools:

- > Offer intensive training/certifications
- Often help locate employment upon graduation

Community or Junior Colleges:

- Offer core courses and electives that will transfer to a 4 year university or college as well as Associates Degrees and some Bachelors Degrees
- > Offer trade certification and training programs
- Good affordable transition for students not wanting to start off at a large college/university



4-year Colleges and Universities

- Check with the school to see if you need to take SAT/ACT & send scores (some are test optional and policies vary)
- □ Complete applications early (DEADLINES)
- Send transcript to each school
- □ Send recommendations (if necessary)
- □ Apply for financial aid FAFSA/TAFSA
- □ Apply for housing



College and Military Visits

- ➢ Available to Juniors and Seniors
- **Two days** given for college visits each year.

They do not carry over.

- **Four days** total for military visits while in HS
- Student picks up form in the vestibule or the attendance office.
- ➤When you visit the college of your choice or with the military recruiter, make sure you get them to stamp the college/military visit form.
- ➢ Return the college/military visit form to the attendance office upon return.

Steps to Completing College Applications

- ★ Fill out the application carefully and thoroughly, including required essays.
- ★ Request an official transcript be sent to the college from the Registrar's office or click here→www.tinyurl.com/JVHSRegistrar
- ★ Check with the school to see if you need to take SAT/ACT & send scores (some are test optional and policies vary)
- ★ Apply to all schools as early as possible and check school admissions website for deadlines.
 - Early consideration deadlines: Oct. 1-Nov. 1
 - Regular consideration deadlines: Jan. 1-Feb. 1
 - Rolling admissions: continuous
 - Have essays proofread by an English teacher.



Registrar's Office

Order transcripts for college admission and scholarships Fill out transcript request form in the Registrar's office or the online order located on Registrar's page of school website

Official (mailed) Transcripts = first 5 are free, then \$5.00 each thereafter

Unofficial Transcripts = \$1.00

Electronic Transcripts = FREE (most TX schools)

Allow 3 days for processing of transcripts

Automatic Admission to Texas State public colleges is available for students in the top 10% with the exception of the top 6% for the University of Texas in Austin beginning Fall 2021.

Applications and supporting material must be completed and submitted by each university's deadline.

Letters of Recommendation

- ★ Click <u>https://tinyurl.com/JVFalconResume</u>, complete and send to your counselor or other recommenders for College Applications and Scholarships.
- ★ Recommendation letters are not necessary for most colleges, but may be needed for scholarships.
- ★ Choose someone who knows you well teacher, employer, club sponsor, etc.
- ★ Request letter <u>at least 3 weeks</u> before needed.
- ★ Students, it is good etiquette to write a thank you note to the person recommending you.

Financial Aid

- Grants & Scholarships-Funds are awarded which do not have to be repaid
- Loans Funds accepted must be repaid with interest
 - Subsidized loans interest paid by government until student is done with school.
 - Unsubsidized loans interest accrues while student is in school.
- Work Study Funds earned on an hourly basis for specific campus jobs and applied to tuition balance

Financial Aid

- FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) financial aid application must be completed to receive federal grants and loans. <u>www.fafsa.ed.gov</u>
- TASFA (Texas Application for Student Assistance) financial aid application for students who are state residents but not U.S. citizens. <u>www.collegeforalltexans.com</u>

Proof of completion is now required for graduation!

Financial Aid

- ★ Many scholarship opportunities require students to fill out the FAFSA application and submit their Student Aid Report (SAR) regardless of financial need.
- ★ Apply for an FSA ID number here: <u>Create an FSA ID</u>
- ★ Both student and parent need their own unique FSA ID. If you have an older sibling who has applied for financial aid, your parents may already have created one.

FAFSA application opens beginning October 1st using prior year's tax info.

- Students who want to play college sports should register at the beginning of their junior year
- A transcript should be sent to the Eligibility Center from the high school registrar's office after completion of the junior year.
