

LCHS Campus-Wide Testing Schedule

- For students to prepare adequately for all summative assessments and to minimize the number that occur per day, the campus testing schedule has been created. Following this schedule requires adherence by all teams/teachers as it is in the best interests of students.
- When teams would like to request an alternate test date, the Team Leader will contact his/her Department Chair (DC). The DC of the requesting department will email the DCs of the assigned date's subject areas (and copy the Director of Instruction) to request a trade.
- Major campus-generated assessments should not occur in the same course back to back so that students receive the appropriate feedback from teachers before being asked to display additional mastery in the content. Students require timely, direct teacher feedback so that their mastery level increases between academic performance measures.
- Students who *choose* to enroll in multiple classes within the same department may experience a greater number of tests and/or assessments in a smaller timeframe and/or on the same date.
- There will be additional requirements by the district to administer DPMs and TEKS tests. That timeline is determined by ISC.
- A student may request an alternate test date directly to his/her teacher if a test occurs outside the guidelines of the campus testing schedule.
