Visual Arts Classes: A brief summary

Visual Arts 1

Works on building up basic art skills, in a variety of materials, with a focus on the Elements and Principles of Art. Start developing your own artistic voice.

Visual Arts 2

Focuses on expanding artistic skill set, while improving artistic voice through thematic artworks. More student choice, in material as well as artistic execution.

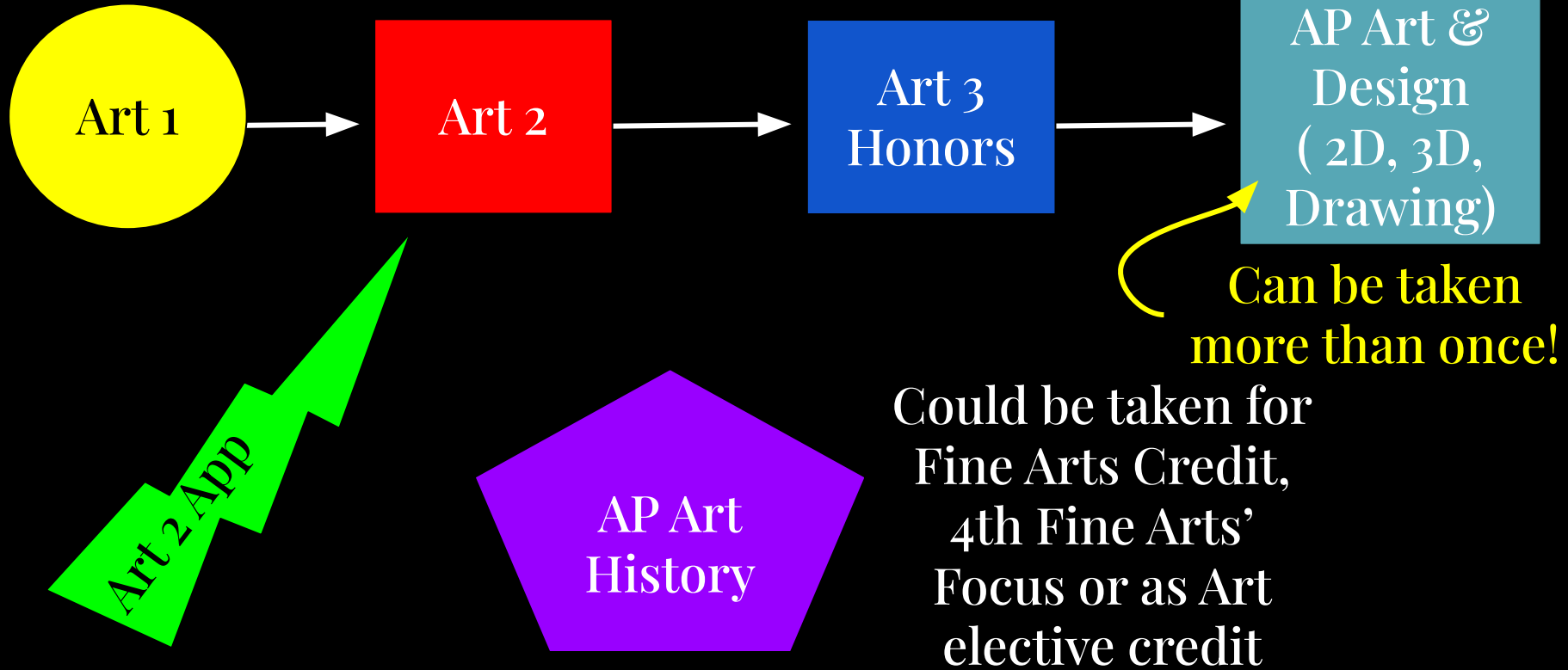
Visual Arts 3 Honors

Further development of personal voice and artistic skills. Work toward artistic skill mastery with a clear personal voice, interpreted by an audience/viewer with accuracy.

AP Art & Design

Driven by the artist's ideas. Clear artistic concepts/perspective with Mastered Artistic skills. Class is the culmination of Visual Arts Course with the ability to earn College Credit, through College Board

Visual Art Pathways



Concert Band and Percussion Ensemble

- No Experience necessary.
- Two separate classes (daily, year long)
- Perform as one Band.
- Register for the class associated with your instrument
- After school commitments: rehearsals/performances



Guitar Class

- 1 semester course
- Learn guitar/music theory basics
- Perform in small group/ensemble



Orchestra (1st period)

- Previous experience encouraged but not necessary!
- Year-long class
- All grades together: Freshmen-Seniors
- Performance Based - full and chamber
 - Veteran's Day Assembly
 - Holiday Concert
 - Spring Concert

Choir (2nd period)

- No previous experience required!
- Year-long class
- All grades together: Freshmen-Seniors
- Performance Based
 - Veteran's Day Assembly
 - Holiday Concert
 - Caroling
 - Spring Concert
