Please note that a portfolio is not required, or even expected, to be accepted into the Audio Academy! We recognize that some students have had more opportunities than others to gain prior performance experience or learn technical skills in Audio Production, so we don't want that to be a factor in admissions. However, we are looking for students across WCS who share a common passion for music and want to pursue college and career opportunities in the industry. In the past, students have asked if they can share a portfolio along with their submitted application to help demonstrate that passion to help us better get to know them.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING YOUR MUSIC SAMPLES

- Please submit a maximum of 4 projects.
- Please save your music file/s as MP3s or WAVs.
- When naming your files, be sure to include your first and last name and the name of the composition.

I will be listening to your work with these criteria in mind:

- Creativity and originality: are you bringing an original or unique idea to your work?
- Skills: do you have a good understanding of how to use the recording system?
- Craftsmanship: do you pay attention to detail? do you have an understanding of the components of your project?
