



Banquete Pathways in Technology Early College High School

Banquete P-TECH has partnered with Del Mar College in order to merge high school and college coursework, providing students the opportunity to earn up to 60 college credit hours towards an Associate's degree, as well as an industry certification or a two-year post-secondary certificate at no cost to the student or his/her family.



Banquete P-TECH offers students a pathway that will lead to post-secondary credentials. It is a collegiate experience that encourages students to continue the journey into higher education.

- Opportunity to graduate with 60 college credit hours and an Associate's degree that may be transferrable to any state-supported college or university in Texas.
- Dual Credit courses mirroring a college setting offered in partnership with Del Mar College.
- Academic Counseling to help students develop skills needed for post high school success.

Program Requirements/Expectations

Banquete P-TECH will provide students with teachers and support teams to encourage student achievement. AVID strategies in writing, inquiry, collaboration, organization, and reading (WICOR) are incorporated into classes.

College and career advising is provided to plan future career and educational options and opportunities.

There are no criteria to be placed in Banquete P-TECH, but students must be willing to work toward an Associate's degree, industry certification, or post-secondary certificate.

Internship, apprenticeship, and job training programs will be part of our school implementation.
