655 STUDENT AWARDS POLICY

I. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to develop avenues for recognizing student achievements in the areas of attendance and student grades.

II. General Statement of Policy

AFSA will have the following award areas and criteria:

1. AFSA High Honors qualifications:
 - a. High Honors is determined at the end of each trimester.
 - b. Student is enrolled full-time at AFSA and/or an authorized PSEO program during that trimester.
 - c. Student has earned credits in CIS, AP or college level courses while enrolled at AFSA.
 - d. Student is a junior or senior student at AFSA.
 - e. Student maintains a cumulative GPA of 3.67 or greater.
2. "A" Honor Roll qualifications:
 - a. Honor roll is determined at the end of each trimester.
 - b. Student was enrolled at AFSA as a full-time student for the entire grading period.
 - c. Student has earned a GPA of 3.67 or higher during that grading period.
3. "B" Honor Roll qualifications:
 - a. Honor roll is determined at the end of each trimester.
 - b. Student was enrolled at AFSA as a full-time student for the entire grading period.
 - c. Student has earned a GPA of 3.0 to 3.66 during that grading period.
4. Perfect Attendance Award Qualifications:
 - a. Attendance is determined at the end of each trimester.
 - b. Student was enrolled at AFSA as a full-timer student for the entire attendance period.
 - c. Student was present at AFSA each day of the attendance period.
 - d. Student had no more than three excused tardies during the attendance period.

III. Procedures

The AFSA Administrator or their designee will develop procedures for recognizing students each grading period.
