801 Facility Use Policy

The AFSA High School (the "School") Board of Directors recognizes that community groups may request the use of the school facility and grounds (the "Facility") for community related and school-related activities. Typically, the School does not rent or allow the use of its Facility by outside groups. In limited circumstances, however, the School may agree to contract with groups to use the Facility for school-related or community purposes. The Board of Directors shall set the criteria for such use and shall determine the cost, if any, that will be charged for use. A completed Facilities Use form and certificate(s) of insurance must be submitted to the School for review, as a condition of the approval of use. Approved users of the Facility must comply with all conditions of use set by the School, including restrictions on areas of the School for use; supervision and management of attendees at the user's event; prohibition on alcohol, drug and tobacco use anywhere within or on the grounds of the Facility; and agreement to reimburse the School for any damage, injury or loss occasioned by the user's use of the Facility. The School may require a hold harmless agreement when it deems it to be warranted.
