

ACT NCR (non-college reportable) March 12-14

Volusia County Schools will be offering a unique opportunity for High School Juniors and Seniors who have yet to earn a passing score on the FSA ELA, FAST Reading, and/or Algebra 1 EOC or obtain a concordant score using the ACT/SAT or PERT, to sit for an "in school ACT" test administration. This special administration will allow students the potential to earn a concordant score needed for a standard high school diploma. Students who choose to use this "in school ACT" test option will only be permitted to use these scores as a concordant score for graduation purposes.

The "in school ACT" test administration cannot be used for:

- Bright Futures
- College Admissions
- Scholarship Opportunities

The "in school ACT" test administration will occur on **MARCH 12 English, MARCH 13 Math and MARCH 14 Reading**. Your student has been selected to participate in this opportunity in hopes of obtaining a concordant score. There is no cost to your student to take this test, however you must sign and return this letter by **MARCH 10TH**.
