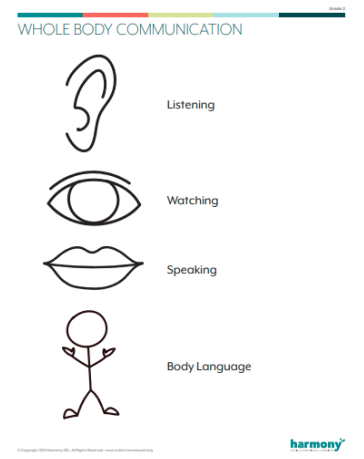

This month we focused on communication. Lessons focused on attending to messages, both when you are speaking as well as when others are speaking and being open to their message and perspective. Social skills were discussed and practiced, including body language and tone, recognizing when to use different types of communication, and using communication to solve problems.

Students learned that conversations require verbal and nonverbal communication such as taking turns, listening, and responding as well as catching ourselves when we interrupt or ignore others. Students practiced making on-topic comments, and questions using listening and speaking skills.
