Welcome back from Fall Break!

Message from Director Robles: We are happy to share with you that, beginning after fall break, parents and families are invited to join us on Fridays for our morning meetings. These meetings are held every day on the playground with students from first to fifth grade.

Fridays in particular are special because we sing our school song with drums and other fun instruments.

If you would like to join us for one of these meetings, please take the following into account:

- Around 8:17 a song starts playing over the speakers around the playground.
 - Upon hearing the song, our supervisors blow their whistles 1 time to indicate that it is time for all children to stop and take a knee or sit.
- After all the students have "frozen", we blow the whistles twice to indicate that it is time to put balls away.
- We blow our whistles 3 times to indicate that it is time for students to line up.

After most of our students are in line, we begin our meeting.

A short message is shared, we sing our school song and then the students are dismissed to their classes.

Our routine moving forward will be to dismiss parents first and then students. We ask that, upon dismissal from the playground, parents and families exit through the main entrance as the exit to Bermuda Street will not be available at this time. We ask that there are no crowds in the walkways so that our students do not encounter difficulties or obstacles getting to their classes.

If you would like to stay on campus after our morning meeting, please make arrangements with the teacher or staff you will be working with or visiting beforehand and sign-in at the front office as a volunteer/visitor.

We look forward to seeing you on Friday, October 13th, for our first morning meeting with parents this year!


School Safety and Parking lot: Please remember that we strive to provide a safe environment here at FGIS. We ask our families to follow our drop off and pick up guidelines to keep our students safe in the parking area. Remember to pull all the way forward on the white zone to drop off or pick up your child. Do not double park or get off your car. If you'd like to walk your child to class, park in a space that is available and not a designated parking space. Lastly, if you do not have a handicap permit, do not park in our Handicap parking as it takes that spot away from someone that really needs it. Please do NOT block driveways on Trinity St. Thank you for your cooperation.
