#### Message from Director Robles and Sub Director Mak on School Safety and Parking Lot:

Please remember that we strive to provide a safe environment here at FGIS. We ask our families to follow our drop off and pick up guidelines to keep our students safe in the parking area.

- Remember to pull all the way forward on the white zone to drop off or pick up your child.
- Do not double park or get out of your car while in the drop off or pick up zone and please be patient.
- It is very important that we do not park in the red zones as it can block traffic and become a safety concern.
- Our crossing guards are there to ensure that everyone crosses safely. Please show respect for the STOP and GO sign.

- In the event that you would like to walk your child to class, please park in an unassigned parking spot that is available.
- State law mandates that handicap parking spaces be made available to those with a Handicap Permit ONLY. Occupying those spaces takes that spot away from someone that really needs it.
- Please be mindful of our neighbors and show respect for our community by not blocking driveways on Trinity St.

- If a student doesn't want to wear a costume they can wear their pajamas for the day



**Fiesta de Bicicletas:** We hope you can join us for a fun and free event located in our school playground. If you registered your student for a bike at our Super Sabado you will be contacted only if your bike is ready. You will also have the opportunity to register your student on a first come first serve basis at our Fiesta de Bicicletas event and you will receive your students bike at our next event or when the bike is ready. In addition, we will also be accepting bike donations at our Fiesta de Bicicletas but only those that meet our criteria please see guidelines below.



### Fiesta de Bicicletas - Bike Donation Guidelines:

We will accept kids bikes of all types and sizes, but especially 24" and bigger. Flat tires and broken or missing parts are okay; however, we can't restore paint and we can't reverse corrosion.

Before donating your bike, ask yourself:

- Could an experienced mechanic make this bike functional and safe in one hour or less?
- Is the bike substantially free of rust and corrosion?
- Is the bike clean enough that you could offer it as a gift without embarrassment?

If the answers are all "yes" then we'll gladly receive the bike. If you're unsure, snap a few pictures and send them to <u>hwolnick@gmail.com</u>.

If the bike needs parts, it will cost us money and we're doing this all as volunteers. If you're able, \$10 along with the bike will really help us cover the costs of parts and the helmets and locks we give out with the bikes! You can give the money on our **<u>go fund me page</u>**.
