RETHINKWASTE SCHOOL RECYCLING AND COMPOST PROGRAM November 2023 – Fiesta Gardens International School

RethinkWaste is very excited to partner with Fiesta Gardens International School to provide students and staff with access to recycling and composting services at no-cost to the school.

The RethinkWaste team was on campus the week of November 27th, working directly with students and school staff to help identify the needs of Fiesta Gardens and deliver resources and technical assistance.

- Materials: Fiesta Gardens received new recycling, compost, and liquid containers, posters and stickers, and educational materials.
- Environmental Education: Students learned about the new program and the importance of recycling and composting at assemblies presented by RethinkWaste and San Mateo County Office of Sustainability ctaff

Training: During every lunch period, the RethinkWaste team coached staff and students about what lunch items go into each bin.

By participating in the new program, Fiesta Gardens has already drastically reduced the amount of material sent to the landfill. Check out the image to the right to see exactly how much!



Information meetings are for incoming 6th Grade families for the school year 2024/2025.



Message from Director Robles and Sub Director Mak on School Safety and Parking Lot: Please remember that we strive to provide a safe environment here at FGIS. We ask our families to follow our drop off and pick up guidelines to keep our students safe in the parking area.

- Remember to pull all the way forward on the white zone to drop off or pick up your child.
- Do not double park or get out of your car while in the drop off or pick up zone and please be patient.
- It is very important that we do not park in the red zones as it can block traffic and become a safety concern.
- Our crossing guards are there to ensure that everyone crosses safely. Please show respect for the STOP and GO sign.
- In the event that you would like to walk your child to class, please park in an unassigned parking spot that is available.
- State law mandates that handicap parking spaces be made available to those with a Handicap Permit ONLY. Occupying those spaces takes that spot away from someone that really needs it.
- Please be mindful of our neighbors and show respect for our community by not blocking driveways on Trinity St.
