






Tri-County Opportunities Council Mission Statement

Tri-County Opportunities Council will investigate the impact of poverty throughout our nine county service area and will work, in partnership with individuals, families and communities to provide opportunities that supports movement towards stability and self-sufficiency.



Community Services Block Grant Program (C.S.B.G.)

- Provides comprehensive needs assessments, information, referrals, and numerous programs that
 offer engagement activities to eligible customers to obtain self-sufficiency for employment, youth,
 education, housing, medical, and emergency needs.
- Offers various housing programs to those facing homelessness or on the verge of becoming homeless.
 In addition, engagement activities are provided to ensure housing is affordable and sustained to prevent future homelessness.
- Awards annual educational scholarships to income-eligible residents attending an Illinois institution of higher learning.
- Bureau County Food Pantry provides food to meet meal gaps to families residing in Bureau County.

Foster Grandparent Program

- Provides meaningful volunteer opportunities for limited-income seniors 55 years of age and older.
- Offers supportive one-on-one services to children in an educational setting, boosting the child's overall success in reading, math, spelling, art, and other constructive projects.

Early Head Start/Head Start Program

- Provides comprehensive early childhood education, health, nutrition, and parent engagement services to children from birth to 5 years of age, expectant mothers, and their families.
- The program's services and resources are designed to foster stable family relationships, heighten family resiliency, enhance children's physical and emotional well-being, and establish an environment to develop skills toward school readiness and a love of life-long learning.
- Families must meet the eligibility criteria established by the federal government.

Percentage of Income Payment Plan (P.I.P.P.)

• Helps customers manage their utility bills by making monthly utility payments more affordable year-round. Payments are based on a percentage of household income and stay consistent every month.

Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (L.I.H.E.A.P.)

- Helps eligible households stay safe and healthy by providing financial assistance to meet immediate home energy needs and offset energy costs.
- Provides heating assistance, crisis assistance, and emergency furnace repair and replacement.

Weatherization Program

- Provide home energy upgrades to income-eligible homeowners and renters to help save energy and ensure the home is a healthy and safe place to live.
- Evaluates the home to determine if weatherization is needed. Opportunities to make the house more
 energy efficient include but are not limited to sealing air leaks, adding insulation, and during a safe
 working furnace.
