

**LETTER OF AGREEMENT**  
**Between Longview School District No. 122**  
**And Longview Education Association**

The Longview School District No. 122 (“District”) and Longview Education Association (“Association”) hereby confirm the following agreements related to the Wit and Wisdom Building Support Teacher for the 2023-24 school year.

WHEREAS, Wit and Wisdom is part of a literacy curriculum recently adopted by the District at the beginning of the 23-24 school year;

WHEREAS, teachers have received curriculum training from the company that supplied the curriculum materials

WHEREAS, after the first year of implementing Wit and Wisdom some elementary District teachers have communicated a higher level of support needed to teach Wit and Wisdom;

The District and the Association agree to the following:

**A. Selection and Compensation**

1. Each building administrator at the (8) eight elementary schools will select a certificated staff member to become a Wit and Wisdom Building Support Teacher.
2. The certificated staff member will be chosen on the basis of experience, comfort with, and effective use of Wit and Wisdom curriculum materials.
3. The Wit and Wisdom Building Support teacher position is a voluntary position.
4. Each Wit and Wisdom Building Support Teacher will receive a stipend of \$1200.00

**B. Responsibilities**

1. Wit and Wisdom Building Support teachers will attend 4 after school trainings (90 minutes each) outside of the employees’ contracted time. The training will be provided by the District.
2. The Wit and Wisdom Building Support teachers will provide (4) four 10-15 minute staff meeting trainings on Wit and Wisdom strategies.
3. The Wit & Wisdom Building Support teachers will be available to answer questions from teachers about the curriculum.

**C. Duration**

1. This MOU will be effective August 29, 2023, and expire on the last instructional day of the 2023-24 school year. All other provisions of the CBA will remain in full force and effect. After the expiration of this MOU, neither party may cite it as or seek to introduce it as evidence of past practice or precedent of any kind.
