MATHEMATICS

Summer Academy's math program teaches basic arithmetic concepts as well as geometry, patterns, time, and problem solving. PHONICS

Phonics is a program that is used in conjunction with our literature-based reading series. New learning is presented in increments, and each increment is reviewed weekly,\.

Homework consists of decoding words and reading a short story for comprehension nightly. Phonics tests are given after five lessons are completed.
