Broadcast team members receive instruction and experience, gathering, editing and broadcasting news and sports. Broadcast team members learn and use industry standard video recording and editing equipment. Team members utilize communication skills including ad-libbing, reporting, interviewing, and play-by-play sports announcing. They plan, produce and submit work for broadcast, sell advertisement, and cover school activities outside the school day. Broadcast team members utilize professional standards and practices when acquiring and preparing news for television broadcasting.


Advanced Placement (AP) Science Courses

- As a 9th grader, you cannot take an AP science class
- ☐ Future AP Science options with prerequisites
 - AP Biology—Need Chemistry, but Biology is also STRONGLY recommended
 - ☐ AP Chemistry—Need Chemistry
 - ☐ AP Physics 1—Need Algebra 1 but more math is highly recommended
 - ☐ AP Computer Science completed Algebra 2
