

Students will need to log onto the StudentVUE website

- Select *Course Request*
- Select Click here to change course requests
 - Add a course Search by Course ID (Online Reg. Code listed by each course below).

For yearlong courses you must enter both the A and B options.

- Students will need a total of 14 classes (minimum of 7.0 credits).
- Select Add Request (for all 14 selections)
- Select- Add Alternate to choose your alternate courses (these will be used if other options are unavailable)
- Select- Click here to return to course request summary to double check you have selected all 14 requests, along with alternates.
- Make sure you have 14 course selections and 2 alternate courses!
- You can make ANY CHANGES in Student Vue until MARCH 12th!
