What is a CTE Ambassador?

A CTE Ambassador is a student who is “the face” of Career and Technical Education (CTE) at the Calhoun County Career Academy. They champion their CTE program or academy and strive to gain a competitive advantage through this leadership opportunity.

How were CTE Ambassadors nominated?

CTE teachers nominate up to three students in their program.
