J. Tyler George Baseball/Softball Scholarship 2024

Purpose: To provide a one-time college scholarship of \$500 each to an eligible senior at Troy High School, for one who has played baseball and for one who has played softball **at least two years during high school.**

Award: One (1) non-renewable scholarship will be awarded to two (2) persons selected by Mr. and Mrs. Thomas George and/or Chris and Katie Edwards.

Eligibility:

1. Applicant must be a senior at Troy High School.
2. Applicant must have at least a 2.5 GPA (unweighted)
3. Applicant must demonstrate at least 90% attendance.
4. Applicant must demonstrate involvement within the school and community.
5. Applicant must be graduating from Troy High School in May/June 2023.
6. Applicant must show proof of enrollment from the college or university they intend to enroll at in **Fall 2024.**
7. Applicant must submit ALL completed materials by the deadline (**April 15, 2024**).

Application: Please submit the following documents in a sealed manila envelope. Please place your name in the upper right-hand corner of the envelope.

1. Scholarship application
2. Scholarship essays
3. Two (2) letters of recommendations: at least one letter from a teacher
4. Proof of enrollment to the college/university being attended/copy of acceptance letter

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: Essays and recommendation letters **must be typed**, double-spaced, in 12-point Times New Roman or an equivalent font, with numbered pages and one-inch margins.

ESSAY PROMPTS:

1. **In 500--700 words, write an essay responding to the following topic: Describe how your heritage, family, and the community in which you grew up have impacted your desire and motivation to obtain a college or technical degree. Additionally, be sure to include what you intend to accomplish with your degree and how you will give back to your community.**
2. **In 500-700 words, write an essay responding to the following topic: Describe how playing baseball or softball is like the game of life. Include your chosen position on the field to play.**

Please submit the completed application and materials in a sealed envelope to Mrs. Schreiber, Administrative Assistant/Guidance no later than **Monday, April 15, 2024.** (Late applications will not be considered)
