Developing Mission-Aligned Servant Leaders

The goal of St. David's School Merit Scholarship program is to recognize and develop students who exhibit a desire to become servant leaders. Recipients of a merit scholarship will demonstrate a willingness to be mentored as well as mentor others and will be active, positive role models in the life and mission of St. David's School. Current and prospective rising ninth and tenth grade students are encouraged to apply.

To qualify for a merit scholarship, applicants must exhibit and maintain the following:

- consistent and strong academic performance (3.5 GPA or higher)
- daily attendance of 90% or higher
- exemplary character and conduct becoming a leader among their peers
- a demonstrated commitment to giving their very best in the pursuit of the mission of St. David's School
- the qualifications of the specific scholarship for which they are applying

Candidates will be reviewed and evaluated by the scholarship selection committee based on both their merit scholarship application, and either the information included in their completed application for admission (prospective students), or on their current and past academic and co-curricular contributions at St. David's (current students).
