




South Whidbey School District

What is South Whidbey School District's ITK program?

- ITK is a classroom for any child who turns 4-years-old by August 31st.
- ITK prioritizes serving children who have had limited preschool experience, qualify for free or reduced lunch, dual language learners, and students who may receive services on an IEP
- ITK is a no cost, 5 day a week program 8:30-3:00 p.m. (Wednesdays 1:30)
- ITK uses research-based curriculum that is developmentally appropriate for 4-year-olds
- SWSD bus transportation and meals are available for ITK students.
- ITK is taught by a certificated South Whidbey School District teacher

If you are interested in the potential of your child participating in the ITK program for the 2025-2026 school year, please complete the attached survey. South Whidbey staff will then reach out to families who meet qualification for the program to discuss enrollment. Please complete this survey by May 31st. We will accept our first round of applicants in mid-June.
