On a separate sheet of paper(s), submit an essay (approx. 250 words) that addresses the following points: (a) information on activities while in the Brockton Public School system; (b) special interests or work experience, and (c) plans for further education and career goals. The letter will be reviewed and evaluated by a panel formed by the Scholarship Committee. The panel will judge all the letters submitted by eligible students anonymously. Therefore, it is very important that in your letter you do not refer to your name or a family member's identity. The panel is impartial and any indication of who the applicant is will disqualify that applicant and panel member, holding up the scholarship process. Also, an applicant will be disqualified immediately if he/she discusses his/her application and letter with panel members, or they do not follow the proper letter format.
