English Language Learners

English language learning students benefit from strategies in the classroom from skilled general education teachers as well as the assistance of specialized paraprofessionals through both pull-out and in-class support.

Special Education

At Rummel Creek, students with dyslexia benefit from proven learning strategies provided by their teachers. Students with special learning needs are served in Life Skills, Resource and APPLE (Autism Program Preparing Learners for Excellence) classrooms as well as in-class support in general education classes when appropriate. With a focus on fostering independence and vocational readiness, the continuity of special education programs in Spring Branch ISD empowers students with the tools they need to thrive academically and in future pursuits.

Physical Education

Not only do students participate in health fitness in the gym, they also visit the movement lab as part of their special rotation. There, they work on team building skills, in addition to achieving health and fitness learning objectives. The school's gym is staffed with two teachers and two paraprofessionals who are all highly skilled and enthusiastic about their craft.

Fine Arts

The fine arts team collaborates with one another to support students in the acquisition of new skills, as well as self-confidence. Students have many opportunities to express their talents, including performances, art shows and connections with the middle and high schools.

Gifted & Talented

RCE has a very high percentage of students who qualify for gifted and talented services. Kindergarten through second grade Gifted & Talented (GT) students participate in the Primary Gifted Program (PGP) with the librarian on campus. Third through fifth graders travel to the SPIRAL program at The Bendwood School once a week. All classroom teachers at RCE are GT certified.
