Special Education

Based on individual needs and goals for meaningful progress, a blend of programs and services supports students with diverse learning needs and abilities. In addition to Resource and in-class support, Meadow Wood also has a Medically Fragile unit and an AIM (Autism Intervention and Management) unit. With a focus on fostering independence, life skills and vocational readiness, the continuity of special education programs in Spring Branch ISD empowers students with the tools they need to thrive academically and in future pursuits.



Physical Education

Health fitness teachers put the "FUN" in fitness at Meadow Wood Elementary. In addition to daily health fitness activities, students are also engaged in the school's Motor Lab. Coaches from feeder schools' athletics departments visit Meadow Wood often to generate interest in middle and high school sports teams. MWE students, who are future Tigers and Spartans, enjoy going to games at Spring Forest Middle School and Stratford High School.

Fine Arts

The art teacher provides weekly classes that allow students to creatively express themselves while developing skills that form a foundation for a lifelong appreciation for and participation in art.

All students also attend a weekly music class. Emphasis is placed on active enjoyment of and accomplishments in music-making. Grade-level performances are held throughout the year to showcase students' acquired musical skills.

Gifted & Talented

MWE serves children identified as gifted and talented through the district's elementary screening process. Kindergarten through second grade Gifted & Talented (GT) students participate in the Primary Gifted Program (PGP) on campus. Third through fifth graders travel to the SPIRAL program at the Bendwood School once a week. All teachers who serve GT students have annual requirements for GT training. Meadow Wood also has several "math movers" who take math a grade level
