Dual Language

Terrace Elementary offers a One-Way Dual Language program to provide students with the foundation to develop their bilingual/bi-literate abilities.

Special Education

Resource, pull-out and in-class supports are provided to students with diverse learning needs and abilities. An AIM (Autism, Intervention and Management) unit is also a part of the Terrace campus. Dyslexia services and speech therapy are available to qualifying students.

Physical Education

The physical education (PE) teacher develops hands-on lessons in which students work on their fine and gross motor skills. Students learn how to support each other and how to be team players. During PE classes, students make connections with the content they are learning with their homeroom teachers.

Fine Arts

Music and art are important elements of the well-rounded education provided at Terrace. Students participate in art and music classes each week. They receive small group and individual coaching as they work on projects and programs. Students get to be creative and express their individuality by participating in these learning experiences.

Gifted & Talented

Terrace offers enrichment opportunities for students identified as gifted and talented through the district's screening process. Gifted & Talented (GT) activities and projects push students to "think outside the box" and learn innovative ways to solve problems.

Kindergarten through second-grade GT students participate in the Primary Gifted Program (PGP) on campus. Third through fifth grade GT students travel to the SPIRAL program at The Bendwood School once a week.

Student Supports

- A full-time school counselor provides guidance lessons, individual planning and a support system for students and families.
- Terrace has a Communities in Schools (CIS) program for students' families who may need support and connections with community resources. A CIS liaison coordinates cooking classes, reading and attendance incentives, student mentoring and much more.
- Students can receive tutorials during and after school.
- The Backpack Buddy Program, in partnership with the school community, provides nutritional weekend food to qualified students and families.
