- Mrs. Curtis shared Acadience Reading Data.
 - Centerville Elementary Middle of Year Growth Comparison. 73% of students are reading at or above grade level.
 - All grades are above 60% in for the middle of year Benchmarks.
 - All students are growing!
- Mrs. Wright shared Acadience Math Data.
 - This is grades K-3rd.
 - We began with 42% of students who were above grade level.
 - MOY 48% of students are at or above grade level.
- Mrs. Bertram talked about drop off/pick up student(s) safety.
 - We are discussing where it would be best to drop off and pick up students.
 - We want to keep the students safe.
- Mr. Cole talked about a meeting that we had with the District Safety person and the Centerville Police Chief.
