- Considering a proposal and seeking feedback.

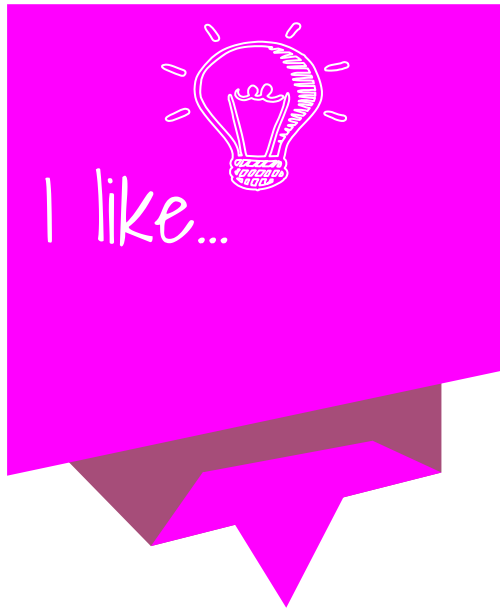


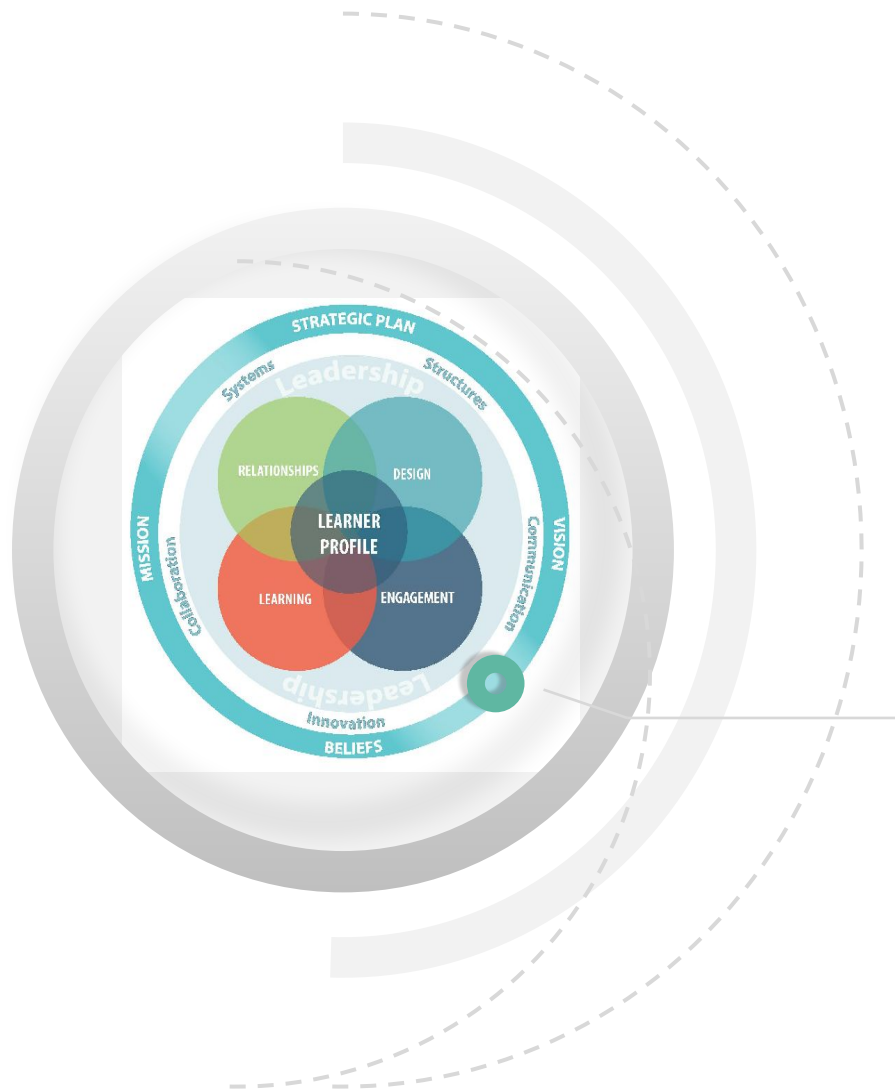

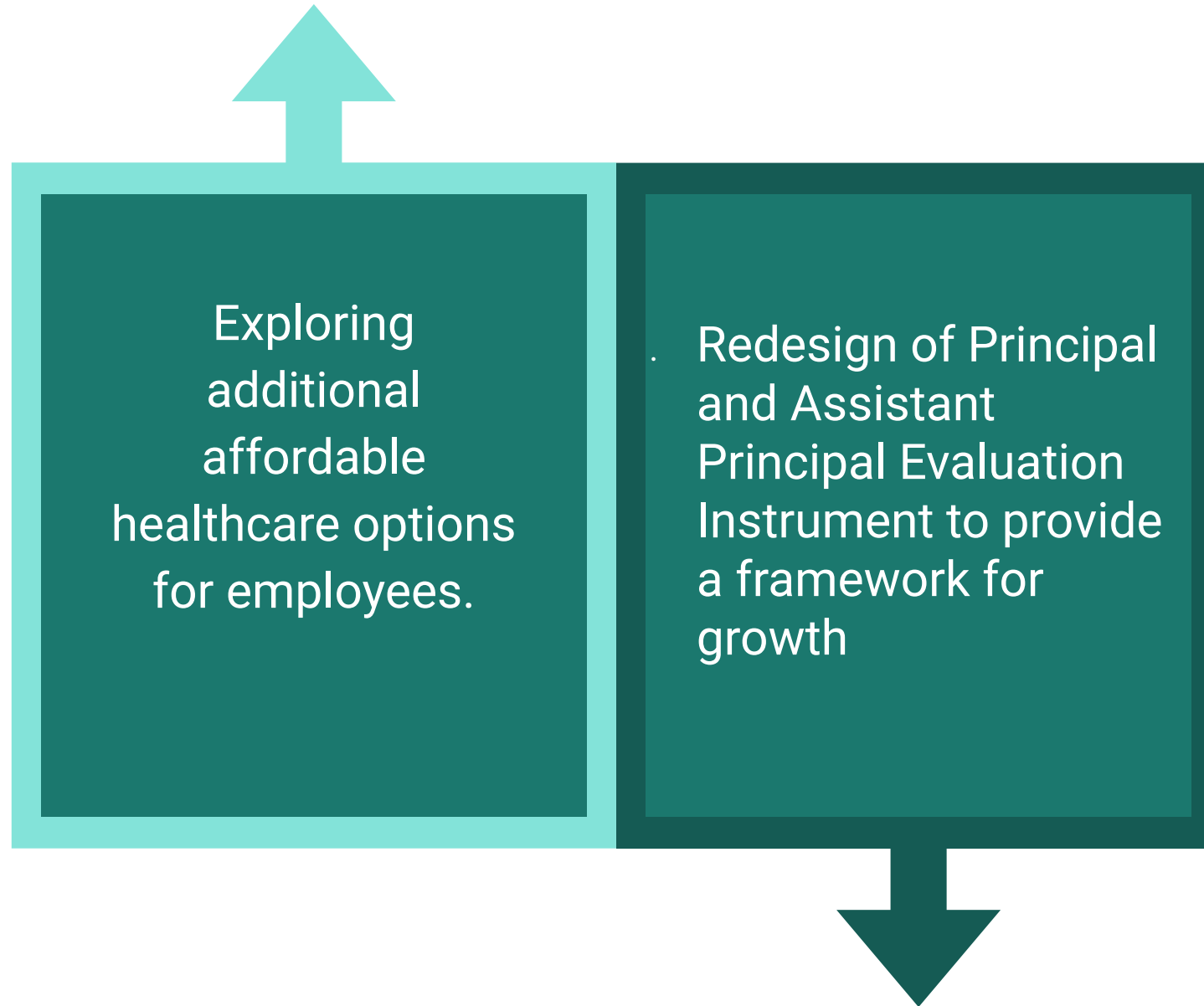


Deeper Dive in DOI

GISD - [District of Innovation](#) (plan linked)

- The 84th Texas Legislature passed **House Bill 1842**, which allows traditional public school districts to exempt themselves from certain education laws if they have a District of Innovation designation. To access the exemptions, a school district must adopt an innovation plan in accordance with **Texas Education Code (TEC), chapter 12A**.
- May 16, 2016 - Georgetown ISD Board of Trustees **adopted a resolution** to initiate the process of exploring the option of designating GISD as a District of Innovation.
- February 8, 2017 - GISD DPC approved the plan by a majority vote.
- February 8, 2017 - The GISD Board of Trustees unanimously approved the District of Innovation plan As required by 19 TAC §102.1307 (d), Georgetown Independent School District submitted a **letter notifying the Commissioner of Education** of the district's destination as a District of Innovation and provided a copy of the DOI plan.

Next Steps with DOI



Exploring more affordable health care options

- Background: TX State Law requires school districts that currently use TRS, to continue to do so. DOI creates an opportunity to offer options in addition to TRS.
- Currently we are exploring a self-funded healthcare option to offer alongside TRS to our employees. Our hope is a more affordable health insurance option.
- We do not know if we are eligible yet.
- No promise or guarantee of a better option.
- Couple of strings attached:
 - Continue to offer TRS plans, at least 1 employee must have TRS plan.
 - Future legislation may remove this option as a whole.

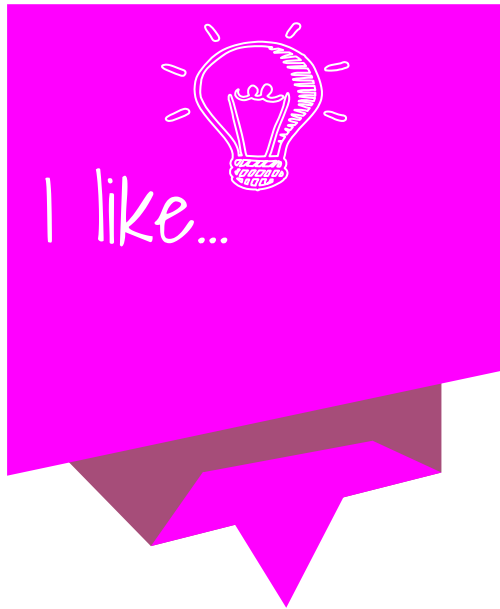
