

**DPC minutes**  
**September 9, 2019**

The second DPC meeting was held on September 9, 2019, at 5:00 pm at the Hammerlun Center for Leading and Learning. Upon signing in, new members were asked to draw a lot to see if they were to serve a one or two year term on DPC.

Dr. Hallmark started off with good things and then touched briefly on the calendar process for this year.

Cindi Pike, Director of CCMR, spoke to the committee in regards to the big picture surrounding CCMR (College, Career, and Military Readiness). She explained the definition of CCMR as defined by TEA and how GISD's Strategic Framework applies CCMR. Ms. Pike also informed the committee of the upcoming Future Readiness Fair on September 24th, 6:00pm-8:00pm, at EVHS. The fair will include booths and seminars from colleges, employers, and military branches. The goal is to reach 2000+ students and parents.

The committee was broken into groups of six to begin SWOT analysis (Strength, Weakness, Opportunities, Threats). The groups reviewed information pertaining to MAP data, PSAT and SAT results, Ethnicity data, Graduation rates, Discipline and Attendance data, and other accountability information. The groups were encouraged to share what they saw as strengths, challenges, and wonderings. Afterward, the groups were asked to write what they saw as the district's strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats on sticky notes in regards to the data. Those notes were then compiled to create an affinity diagram. The feedback from this activity will be used in the DIP writing process.
