

With the 2023 Refresh, the basic model of the A-F Accountability System will remain in place with the 3 domains and the weighted percentages described above. There are however, changes to each of the domains briefly described below.

### **Domain 1: Student Achievement**

Student Achievement measures whether students met expectations on the STAAR test. For high schools, it also measures graduation rate and how prepared students are for success after high school (CCMR)

Changes for 2023:

- Updated cut points for CCMR (earning a score of an A is much more difficult than previously)
- Updated cut points for graduation rates

### **Domain 2: School Progress**

School Progress shows how students perform over time and how the campus' performance compares to other campuses with similar economically disadvantaged student populations

Changes for 2023:

- Implemented a new methodology for calculating growth that includes more students in the calculation
- Added accelerated growth measure

### **Domain 3: Closing the Gaps**

Closing the Gaps tells us how well a campus is ensuring that all student groups are successful

Changes for 2023:

- Updated baseline and targets
- Implemented “supergroups” that combine students groups
- Reduce minimum group size
- Implemented new methodology for calculating points
