KIS International School Bangkok is an International Baccalaureate (IB) World School founded in 1998, delivering four IB programmes (PYP, MYP, DP, and CP). The growing school community has over 800 students from nearly 50 countries.

Secondary school students enjoy two dedicated buildings where they benefit from well-resourced facilities which support instruction of the IB Middle Years and IB Diploma programmes.

Facilities include fully furnished classrooms, a library, an IB Diploma lounge and study center, four science laboratories including a biology, chemistry and physics lab, a black box drama room, art studios, design labs and workshop. They also have access to an exam hall, outdoor sports fields, an indoor gymnasium, swimming pools, a canteen, an auditorium and dance & music studios.






