- Student Council Roles
  - Definition & Expectations
    - The duties of the President shall be to:***
      - A) Preside over all meetings of the Student Council
      - B) Appoint Committees and their respective Chair Persons
      - C) Be the official representative of the Student Council
      - D) Have the power to call special meetings
      - E) Coordinate all actions of the Student Council
      - F) Perform all other duties deemed necessary by him/herself or the Council
      - G) Cast the tie breaking vote
    - The duties of the Vice President shall be to:***
      - A) Preside over the meetings in the absence of the President
      - B) Perform all duties assigned to him/her by the President
      - C) Aid the President in the execution of his/her duties
      - D) Assume the duties of the President in the event of a vacancy in the office of the President
    - The duties of the Treasurer shall be to:***
      - A) Be responsible for all financial transactions and records of the Council
      - B) Preside over the council in absence of the President and Vice President
    - The duties of the Secretary shall be to:***
      - A) Maintain accurate and complete minutes, attendance, and voting records of all meetings and activities

B) Perform all other duties as assigned by the President

***The duties of all members shall be to:***

A) Accept all inquiries, complaints, and suggestions from the student body and faculty

B) Relay these issues to the Council

C) Vote on motions presented during meetings

D) Attend all meetings, or must be excused prior to the meeting

E) Attend all activities initiated by the Student Council, or must be excused prior to the activity

- We reserve the right to lead the conversations/meetings for the first few meetings. There is a lot of teaching/modeling that needs to take place in the beginning.
- Elections
- Elections will begin RIGHT AWAY. Student Council Application Packets will be handed out on Tuesday, 10/17, at 8 am and will be expected back to us before students leave for the day. ANY applications turned in late will NOT be considered for officers. Those students may still be considered for Representative.

- Beginning on Wednesday, 10/18, students will need to have a 30-45 second speech ready to give on WPN. Secretary candidates will speak on Wednesday. Treasurer candidates will speak on Thursday. Vice President candidates will speak on Friday. Presidential candidates will speak on the following Monday.
