

# 2021 Inductees into the East Stroudsburg Area School District Athletic Hall of Fame

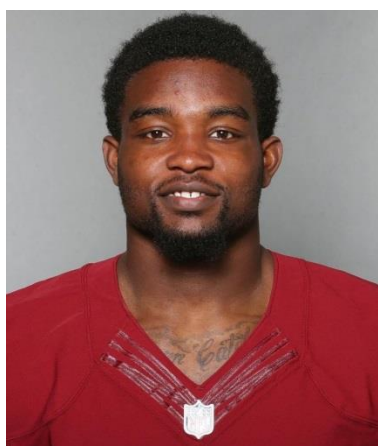
## **Chuck Dailey**



Chuck has spent his entire 32-year professional career within the East Stroudsburg Area School District...He was a teacher, and an extremely successful coach of both basketball and football at the J.S. Bunnell Junior High, and later the J.T. Lambert Intermediate School...Coach Dailey's JTL football teams amassed a record of 26-wins, 1-loss, and 1-tie, while his record during his final 3 seasons as the JTL head basketball coach was 33-wins and 3-losses...He essentially created the football program at East Stroudsburg-North, and served as its first, and most successful football coach for 17 years...Chuck has now served as the North Director of Athletics for 19 years, and is a highly respected leader of a number of committees within both the Eastern Pennsylvania

Conference and District XI.

## **Kyshoen Jarrett**



Kyshoen is a graduate of East Stroudsburg Area High School-South, Class of 2010...As a Cavalier, he was an outstanding member of some of the most successful football teams in East Stroudsburg history, while earning All-League and All-Area recognition...While his success on the football field was indeed tremendous, his accomplishments in the classroom were equally great, thus earning him a full scholarship to Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, where he played 4 years of Division I college football, obtaining his Bachelor of Science degree in 2014...Kyshoen was then selected by the National Football League's Washington Redskins, thus playing in the

NFL...Kyshoen currently serves as a Division I assistant football coach at his alma mater, Virginia Tech University

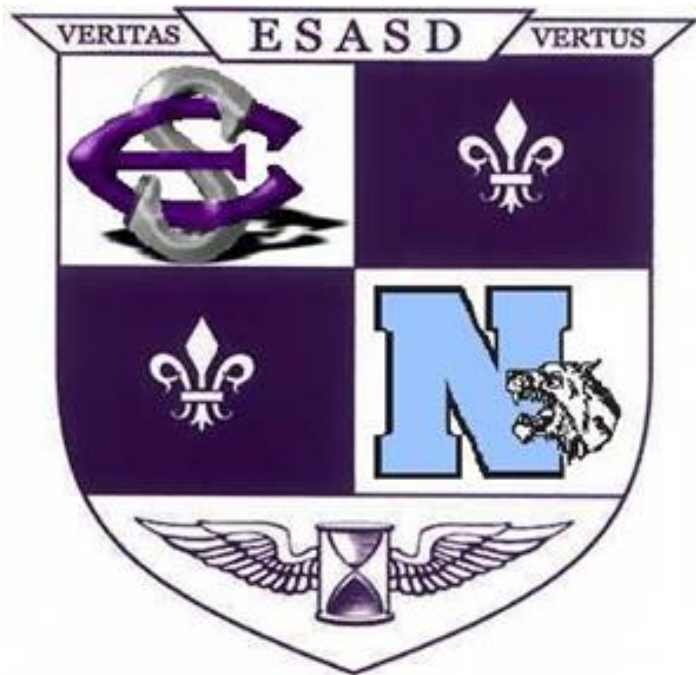
## **Demetrius Lanier**

State Track medals, including a GOLD medal in the 100 meter dash, and a SILVER medal in the 200 meter dash...Demetrius was also a leader on the 2013 Cavalier football team that finished the regular season undefeated...Upon graduation from South, he entered the United States Naval Academy, where he earned numerous Patriot League track medals, and served as the Navy track team captain as a senior...Upon graduation with MERIT from the United States Naval Academy in 2019, Demetrius earned a number of very prestigious degrees from the Navy, and he currently serves our nation on the U.S. Navy submarine, the USS Pasadena, out of Norfolk, Virginia
