More than 300 coaches and high school athletes from the Eastern Dakota Conference will gather at South High School for the eighth-annual EDC Leadership Academy on August 2. The attendees, representing each of the EDC's 12 schools, will receive training on leadership skills from guest presenter Craig Hillier.

Hillier, a motivational speaker focusing on students, educators, and professionals, has presented to more than two million students since 1990. His message "Beyond the Scoreboard: Unlocking a Season of Significance" focuses on setting sights on positive attitudes and behaviors that will provide the foundation for a positive sports season. Each student will receive a copy of Hillier's book, "High School Sports Leader" which provides guidance for how student-athletes can be an effective leader for their taemmates.
