The Northern State University Marching Wolves band, under the direction of Dr. Travis Netzer, is set to rock Davies High School with a spectacular halftime show at its homecoming football game on Friday after performing for and rehearsing with music students during the school day.

The Marching Wolves will visit the Davies High School band classes during periods one and two on Friday and join them in side-by-side rehearsals. The high school students will have the opportunity to play with their collegiate cohorts and get a hands-on experience of what it is like to be a member of an ensemble at the college level. NSU's music professors will also be offering lessons for the high school students throughout the day.
