Discovery Middle School physical education classes will be getting up and active as they explore the entire school grounds on the Selfie Scavenger Hunt this Thursday and Friday. Teams of three to four will compete to complete the scavenger hunt and try to take the most creative selfie at the location of each challenge. The activity will go on all day in gym classes.

The students will have to cover a lot of ground as they race across campus to complete their list of about 15 challenges, which includes items like taking a 20 second video of their team singing a Taylor Swift song, taking a picture or video of the team scoring a touchdown and celebrating in the end zone (hit the Griddy if they can't think of anything else), and taking a picture with Bigfoot.

At the end of the allotted time, the teams will gather to share their experiences and creative approaches. They will send their selfies to their teacher and teachers will print out the best picture from each group to hang in the gym area hallway.

The Selfie Scavenger Hunt encourages social interaction teamwork, creativity, and problem solving. It promotes a positive and inclusive school environment while getting students active and completing a cardiovascular activity.
