Mark Seeba's fourth grade class at Washington Elementary School will get a virtual visit from Seeba's nephew, U.S. Navy Lieutenant Commander Ryan Seeba, who is stationed in Korea, on November 9 ahead of Veterans Day.

Lieutenant Commander Seeba will present to the students via Zoom about the importance of Veterans Day and what it is like to serve in the military. Students will have the opportunity to ask him questions and share stories about their own family members or friends who have served in the military. This opportunity helps provide students context for why we celebrate Veterans Day and helps them better understand the experience of serving in the military.

For many years, Mark Seeba's father Walt, a Korean War veteran, presented to Mark's class about Veterans Day and his military service. Walt Seeba died in 2020 and Lieutenant Commander Seeba, Mark's nephew and Walt's grandson, took over the tradition and has presented to the class each year since.
