Clara Barton Elementary School students will begin an ice skating unit on Monday that will help them gain skills in a potential life-long physical activity. The third-through-fifth graders will gain confidence in their skills on the ice, while getting outside in the fresh air and having fun.

Clara Barton Physical Education Teacher Heather Snowden joins the students on skates for each class as she tries to share her own passion for skating with her students and use her expertise to guide them as they grow as skaters. Snowden was a member of the 1998 United States Synchronized Figure Skating Team.

The ice skating unit is scheduled to last for two weeks, from January 29 through February 9, during the normally scheduled physical education time for each class. The students spend 40 minutes on the ice per session, with the first class of the day taking the ice at 8:10 a.m.
