Three members of the Eagles Elementary School staff are going to get sticky as a reward to their students for exceeding their fundraising goal at the 7th Annual Parent Teacher Association (PTA) Walk-a-Thon fundraiser held on Friday, September 16. Through their efforts running or walking laps around a course at Lemke Park in Fargo, the students raised more than \$23,000 to benefit the school’s PTA.

As a reward for meeting their fundraising goal, students will get to create human sundaes out of Principal Tanya Wrigley-Lingle, Assistant Principal Kimmy Milligan, and Physical Education teacher Kenben Parker. The class that raised the most money and the students that walked the most laps, will get to cover the staff members in all of their favorite sundae toppings, including chocolate sauce, whipped cream, and an array of other messy toppings.

All of the money raised at the Walk-a-Thon event will go towards the enrichment programs and teacher classroom grants sponsored by the Eagles Elementary PTA.
