Davies High School students enrolled in CTE courses at Davies High School will hold an open house for their peers, parents, and the public on Wednesday, December 21. They will showcase the home being constructed by the Construction Trades II students, as well as products created in other CTE classes.

The Davies Jazz Band will bring the festive spirit as they play holiday music in the shop throughout the afternoon. And cookies and hot chocolate will be available for guests as they tour the home and the classroom displays.

In September, Davies students enrolled in Construction Trades II began construction on an 1,800 square foot single-family home. The student-built house has been purchased by a private party, and, once completed in spring 2023, the home will be relocated by the purchaser. There is a waiting list for purchasing future student-built homes.

Students will also showcase products created in other technical education classes, including photography, woodworking, and construction.

Career and Technical Education is an essential component of the educational system, preparing learners for life, careers, and college. In CTE courses, students develop 21st Century Skills as they communicate and collaborate on activities and utilize creativity and critical-thinking to design projects and solve problems.
