The FM Kicks Band will lead the students on a tour through the history of jazz music during a performance presented by the Learning Bank at Horizon Middle School in Moorhead with performances at 9:40 a.m., 10:50 a.m., 11:50 a.m., and 1:50 p.m.

During the concert, the FM Kicks Band, under the direction of Tim Johnson, will perform iconic jazz selections and give brief presentations about the musical era and legendary musicians of the genre. Topics they will cover include Dixieland jazz, 1920's swing, cartoon themes, improvisation, call and response, and modern big band jazz rock.
