Second-through-fifth grade students at Lincoln Elementary School are set to learn about and experience a potential life-long physical activity as they try snowshoeing in their physical education classes. Employees from the school's Adopt-a-School program partner Noridian Healthcare Solutions, LLC will be at the school on Tuesday and Wednesday to help the students get geared up and active outside.

Three 40-minute classes will participate in snowshoeing on Tuesday and Wednesday, with classes beginning at 12:15 p.m., 1 p.m. and 1:40 p.m. Volunteers from Noridian will be there for all three sessions, both days, with the largest number of volunteers from 1:40-2:20 p.m.
