The Clara Barton students will blaze a trail of wide, waffled footprints as they snowshoe their way down the Red River Trail from the Fargo City Water Treatment Plant to Lindenwood Park.

The students will leave Clara Barton Elementary School at about 9:45 a.m. and walk northeast to the water treatment plant. They'll use the bike trail to cross over the hill and snowshoe from there to the park. If they stay on schedule they will arrive at the park between 11-11:15 a.m. and take a break for lunch.

Like the bold adventurers they are, the fifth graders will gather around a campfire to eat their packed lunches outside in the elements at Lindenwood. To make sure they have the energy for the return journey, they will roast marshmallows and hot dogs.

After their lunch, the students will venture back up the same route they just traversed and arrive back at Clara Barton around 12:30 p.m.
